A Record-Breaking Year For SCFB: With YOUR Support, We Did It!

Nationwide in 2023, 7 in 10 lower & middle-income parents were struggling to afford food ahead of this past Thanksgiving, according to recent polling from ParentsTogether Action.

2023 also saw the end of the federal government's pandemic-era food assistance in March, so this is the first holiday season in years without additional help to families in need.

Sedona Community Food Bank's numbers have been reflecting the



same sort of experience for local working families, serving over 200 families on some week's Wednesday distribution days, which is even higher than the worst month of 2020. Previously, April 2020' average of 187 weekly families in need was seen as a high-water number for SCFB, but 2023 has broken that record.

Sedona Community Food Bank has been rising to the challenge. Here are some of the amazing numbers that illustrate just how much SCFB achieved in 2023:

- Assisted 8379 households, or 12,369 people
- Distributed 257, 609 lbs of food
- Donated 33, 580 lbs of food to other area nonprofits
- Filled and delivered 244 boxes of food to homebound clients
- Provided 1950 weekend emergency food packs to children at West Sedona School
- Provided 17,625 snacks to children attending West Sedona school and Red Rock High School
- Our 61 volunteers have donated 8898 hours this year to make all this possible!

The dinner typically attracts around 400 guests for the communal Thanksgiving meal, and was started back in 2008 during the recession. Daher told the Red Rock News that seeing the smiles on people's faces and feeling an air of gratitude is what Thanksgiving is all about. "Thanksgiving has been my favorite holiday for most of my life," he said. "I have great memories as a kid with my family with my mom doing the cooking, and it's a special holiday, and being able to share that with such a diverse group of people is amazing."
